## **This funding will be used to**

- Improve achievement levels whereby 80% of students or higher in all year levels will achieve "A-C" in English.
- Maintain and improve reading achievements in NAPLAN in Year 3 & 5 NMS and U2B.
- Maintain and improve U2B for Year 5 in Writing, Spelling and Grammar and Punctuation
- Achieve national Mean Scale Score in Spelling in Year 3 and Spelling, Writing and Grammar and Punctuation in Year 5.

## **Our initiatives include**

- Implementing Levelled reading and guided reading
- Implementing Quality Teaching and Learning through collaborative inquiry model

## **Our school will improve student outcomes by**

- Employ additional support teachers to collaboratively work with teachers to co plan, co teach and co assess to support students' achievements in English \$77 440
- Employ additional teacher aides to work under teachers' instructions to provide reading practice to improve students' reading ability \$60 000
- Build capacity of teachers to achieve clarity of English Assessment tasks through collaborative planning processes releasing teachers one day each per term. \$35 000
