This funding will be used to

- Improve writing in NAPLAN National Minimum Standard (NMS), Upper Two Band (U2B) and Mean Scale Score (MSS) comparable or better than the nation and QLD schools in Year 5
- Improve writing in NAPLAN U2B comparable or better than the nation and QLD schools in Year 3
- Improve grammar and punctuation in NAPLAN
- Improve writing across the school

Our initiatives include

- Instructional coaching for teachers during English unit writing
- Regular Professional Development in Writing and Coaching to engage in Collaborative Inquiry Cycles (Fisher and Frey) for ALL teachers
- Support to implement oral language programs in Prep
- Professional support for P-2 teachers to implement Early Start
- Monitor student achievement in reading, writing and spelling in P-6 through faces on data (Sharratt and Blanche)
- Case manage relevant students to improve achievement in writing

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing an additional Full Time Equivalent (FTE) in the role of Support Teacher Literacy and Numeracy (STLaN) to coach, mentor and lead and work collaboratively with P-2 cohort of teachers and students	\$84 000
Employing three additional teacher aides to work as para professionals in classrooms to assist teachers in providing support in reading and writing to lift outcomes for students	\$75 000
Employ Indigenous teacher aide	\$6943
