**Special End of Year Parade...** Don't forget that our final parade for the year is on Monday, with some special presentations happening as we recognise our 2026 leaders, farewell various members of our community, particularly our Year 6 cohort. We hope you can join us for what will be a special morning.

**Prepping for Prep... If you haven't done so already,** don't forget to get your Prep enrolment forms in as soon as possible so we can contact you to arrange an enrolment interview either before year's end or early in 2026 when school opens.

**Active Families...** With all the media coverage about obesity, many parents know that their children need to be more active. However, encouraging increased activity is hard if our children are used to watching TV or playing computer games. Research indicates that children should be involved in more than one hour of moderate to vigorous physical activity a day. Parents are critical in influencing their children's lifelong habits and choices to support a happy and healthy life.

Young people are growing quickly, and they are also dealing with enormous physical, emotional and social change. They are often acutely sensitive to their changing body shape and can feel awkward and uncomfortable about being active. They can also genuinely be tired after a day at school, especially during warmer weather. Therefore, it will require sensitivity when discussing and considering activity and exercise opportunities which reflect the needs, interests and skills of your children. Sometimes this may mean a number of trials in certain areas before they will settle on something which suits them. Not every child will be interested in team sports; some children may enjoy more solitary activities such as photography, bike riding, walking or dance classes. Explore the range of activities that are provided by your local community; I am sure you will be pleasantly surprised by what is on offer. Youth activities are often a high priority for local councils. Try the Townsville City Council website.

Take time to plan what will work best in your family to increase physical activity and talk about why it is important. Make it do-able; start with small, achievable goals.

### Here are a few suggestions:

- Cut down screen time for the whole family to one or two hours per day. Allow the children to negotiate which programs are
  most important to them.
- Try to fit activity in your day, such as walking to and from school whenever possible.
- Plan times for family walks or outings that involve physical activity such as a game of frisbee or rounders in the park or exploring a new area together.
- Choose the stairs rather than the lift.

- Create a list of outside activities to put on the fridge, e.g. going for a ride, playing with the pet, going for a walk, digging the garden, dancing to some music and get everyone to add new ideas as they arise.
- Instead of dinner in front of the TV, have dinner around the table and talk about the day's events or plan a family activity.
- Plan a walk or a ride after dinner.
- Get everyone involved in family jobs; a great way for children to earn pocket money or learn valuable life skills.







Our pasture-raised hens are raised within the spacious surrounds of shady mango trees, natural grass and herbage. Feeding only on fresh pasture, predominantly locally grown grains and plant-based proteins, our hens spend their days free to roam - scratching, foraging, dustbathing and exploring a space with only 200 birds per acre. At night, our hens roost in the safety of their trailers which are moved weekly to provide access to fresh pasture and interesting new surroundings.
